



OFFICIAL CONTEST RULES

DRIVE FOR DREAMS

1. **General Information.** Soroptimist International of the Americas, Inc., 1709 Spruce Street, Philadelphia, (Soroptimist) is a tax-exempt, nonprofit corporation which will be holding an opportunity drawing to win either a one-year lease from Valencia Acura (residents of the United States only) or USD\$10,000 cash prize. NO PURCHASE NECESSARY TO ENTER OR CLAIM PRIZE. VOID WHERE PROHIBITED.

Purchase. A donation of USD\$50 for one entry or USD\$100 for three entries is suggested but not required. A DONATION WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING. Any eligible person may request *one* free entry by mailing a written request to the address indicated above. Once a free entry request form has been received by Soroptimist headquarters, the individual will automatically be entered into the drawing. Requests for a free entry must be received by Soroptimist headquarters before July 1, 2012. By submitting the request for one free entry, the person agrees to abide by the rules and regulations of the drawing. 2. **Eligibility.** You must be 18 years of age or older to participate. To elect the vehicle lease prize, the winner must have a valid driver's license, be a U.S. resident **and provide** any required vehicle/liability insurance at the winner's expense.
3. **Prize/Drawing Information.** The prize awarded shall be either:

- A one year lease for an Acura TSX Tech model, MSRP \$33,500 approximate value of 12 monthly lease payments of \$10,000+ with lease end residual of approximately \$23,000 (US residents only)

OR

- USD \$10,000 cash.

No other prize substitution is permitted, except by Soroptimist due to unavailability, in which case a prize of comparable or greater value will be awarded. Soroptimist is not responsible or liable for late, lost, illegible, damaged or misdirected entries.

Prize/Drawing subject to the following additional rules:

- a. The name of the winner will be made available to the media by Soroptimist and Soroptimist will post the winners name on its website. In accepting the winning prize, the winner consents to having their name and photograph published in a variety of media in conjunction with promotional activities associated with Soroptimist.
- b. The winner will be selected by a random drawing conducted by Soroptimist through its authorized representative. The drawing will be held during the 42nd Biennial Convention in Honolulu, Hawaii between July 18-21, 2012. The winner need not be present at the time of the drawing in order to collect their prize. The winner will be notified by telephone and/or by certified mail and/or by email at the discretion of Soroptimist. If a winner cannot be reached within 90 days of initial attempt, winner will be disqualified and an alternate winner will be selected. Prize is non-transferable.
- c. In order to be eligible to participate in the drawing, tickets must be submitted and placed in the official drawing device on or before the drawing date.
- d. Arrangements for the one-year lease prize will be made with Valencia Acura of Valencia, CA and Acura Financial Services.
- e. Arrangements for payment of the USD\$10,000 cash prize will be made with Soroptimist. Payment will be made in U.S. dollars and the winner accepts all responsibility for translation into currency in any other form and any related expenses or bank fees.
- f. Taxes on prizes and all expenses related to acceptance and use of prizes are the sole responsibility of the winner.

- g.** In submitting an entry or accepting the prize each entrant and winner acknowledges that Soroptimist, its directors, officers, members, employees and agents will be released and held harmless for any injuries, losses or damages of any kind, including attorneys fees and expenses, in any way related to or sustained in connection with the contest and the prize awarded. Soroptimist, its directors, volunteers, members, officers, and agents disclaim any and all express and implied warranties, including any implied warranty of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose regarding the opportunity drawing. The prize is offered “as is.”
- h.** Only one name may be stated on the drawing ticket and order form. Presentation of the prize shall be made solely to the entrant. Late, misdirected, incomplete, illegible or damaged drawing tickets will not be eligible and Soroptimist assumes no responsibility for same.
- i.** If the winner is subject to U.S. tax laws, the winner is responsible for providing information to Soroptimist for the purpose of filing a Form 1099G or W-2G with the IRS. The fair market value of the lease and cash prize must be included in the winner’s gross income for tax purposes.
- j.** The amount given for the entry donation is not considered a charitable contribution for purposes of obtaining a charitable income tax deduction and donations are not eligible for recognition in Soroptimist’s Laurel Society.
- k.** The decision of Soroptimist shall be final and binding on any and all matters concerning the drawing.
- l.** All proceeds from the contest, less expenses, will benefit the charitable programs of Soroptimist.
- m.** All federal, state and local laws and regulations apply. Void where prohibited by law.
- n.** Odds of winning depend upon the number of entrants. Approximate retail value of the prize awarded is USD \$10,000.
- o.** Soroptimist staff and their family members are not eligible to participate in the contest.
