There are art galleries, museums, historic architecture, beautiful parks, opera houses, ballet, theatres, concert halls, a zoo, an aquarium, Wimbledon, a 'big wheel', world famous libraries, shops to suit all budgets, cafés, restaurants and coffee houses. So what better place to stay while you take in and enjoy all that London has to offer, than the Soroptimists' 'home from home', our own residential club in West London – Number 63? All rooms are en suite, with TV, wifi, hairdryer, telephone, tea and coffee facilities, prices are competitive and include a freshly cooked English breakfast.

Just five minutes from Lancaster Gate tube station, our lovely Victorian building overlooks Kensington Gardens, a beautiful park to explore. Kensington Palace, home of the Duke and Duchess of Cambridge (and soon to be Prince Harry and his bride Meghan's London Residence) is just a short stroll away through the park. The park was a favourite of Princess Diana and her memorial fountain is very close to Number 63. For fans of JM Barrie's Peter Pan, his statue is to be found in the park nearby too.

Number 63 is the proud holder of a 'three star' guest accommodation rating and was shortlisted for Friendliest B&B in London in 2016. An added bonus is that whenever you stay there you will undoubtedly meet members from other parts of our Soroptimist world, so do come and say hello!

We are only 30-45 mins away from all Heathrow Terminals and both Gatwick Airport Terminals. The Heathrow Express comes in to Paddington station, which is a 15 minute walk around the corner from the front door of Number 63, and the Gatwick Express comes in to Victoria, which is 4 tube stops – 10 minutes - from Bayswater Road.

Room rates range from £80 per night for a single room, through £135 for a twin room for two to share, or £200 for four people to share the family suite. All rates include breakfast.
